CLARKSVILLE – Monique C. Biron, 82, of Clarksville passed away suddenly on Saturday, Feb. 3, 2018, at her residence.

She was born in Sherbrooke, Que., on April 4, 1935, a daughter to the late Edward and Mary Jane (Dube) Giguere. She attended St. Albert School in West Stewartstown and Our Lady of the Mountains Academy in Gorham, NH, and later attended one year of nursing school in Berlin, and worked as a nurse's aide for a short time.

She loved to be in her vegetable and flower gardens, and she was an accomplished piano player. She enjoyed doing puzzles and was a talented quilter. Monique was also an avid reader. 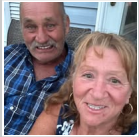

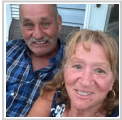
