



Nancy S. Emmons

July 22, 1933 - August 14, 2023

PITTSBURG – Nancy S. Emmons, 90, of Pittsburg, died at the Morrison Nursing Home in Whitefield, N.H., on Monday, Aug. 14, 2023, after a long period of failing health.

She was born in Ashbury Park, New Jersey, on July 22, 1933, a daughter of the late Kenneth and Irene (King) Smith. Nancy studied to become a teacher, and taught third grade in the Ocean Township, N.J. school system for 34 years before retiring and moving to Pittsburg.

In 1986, she was honored by the New Jersey Governor's Teacher's Recognition Program for her years of service, use of effective instructional techniques, rapport with students, and development of a love of learning in students.

Nancy and her husband Bob had vacationed in Pittsburg for many years before retiring, and fell in love with the area and its people. They ultimately moved to a home overlooking the First Connecticut Lake. Following Bob's passing in 2001, Nancy relocated to Clarksville, where she was able to continue gardening, which she enjoyed. Nancy especially enjoyed participating in the activities of the Farnham Memorial United Methodist Church in Pittsburg, where she assisted with events serving its members and visitors. She also crafted items that were made available to the public.

Most recently, she resided in The Morrison in Whitefield, where she received excellent support and care.

She is survived by her sister Jo Ann (Jim) Alexander, and her brothers Kenneth (Erna) Smith and David (Judy) Smith, all of New Jersey.

A memorial service will be held on Monday, Aug. 21, 2023, at 11 a.m. at the Farnham Memorial United Methodist Church in Pittsburg. Burial will immediately follow in the Lake Cemetery in Pittsburg.
