COLEBROOK, NH — Mr. Neil E. Robideau, 62, of Colebrook, NH, passed away suddenly at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook on Saturday morning, Oct. 12, 2013.

He was born in Tupper Lake, NY, on Aug. 28, 1951, a son to the late Nelson and Effie (Bradley) Robideau. Neil was raised in New York and had been a resident of Colebrook for the past 14 years.

Neil was a very familiar face in town, working for various businesses through the Vershire Center. For a time, he was a short-order cook in the staff canteen at The Balsams, as well. He was a very family-oriented person with a wonderful sense of humor, and who enjoyed buying things for others. Neil's favorite pastime was to go to yard-sales, and he enjoyed collecting jewelry and gadgets of all kinds. He was an animal lover, and children seemed to love Neil just as much. He was a man of few words, but one with a huge heart, and he will be missed by his entire family and by many in the community.

He is survived by three brothers, James Robideau and wife Sandy of Eureka, Mont., Nelson W. Robideau and wife Mary Lou of Tupper Lake, NY, and Rodney Robideau of Arizona; his brother-in-law, Raymond Thivierge of Colebrook; as well as numerous nieces and nephews and many friends.

He is preceded in death by a brother, Richard, and his sister, Jane Thivierge.

There will be no public calling hours. The family will have a private memorial for Neil at a time that has yet to be determined, and he will later be interred in the family lot at St. Brendan's Cemetery.
