COLUMBIA, NEW HAMPSHIRE -- Mr. Norman Desaindes, 38, of Columbia, New Hampshire, passed away suddenly on Wednesday morning, September 5, 2007, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook.

He was born November 13, 1968, in Lancaster, NH, the youngest son of Dorila and Rolande (Charest) Desaindes.
