



Norman B. Noyes

August 1, 1940 - April 22, 2025

W. STEWARTSTOWN – Norman Brockney Noyes, 84, passed away peacefully at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown on Tuesday, April 22, 2025, after a long period of ill health.

He was born in Columbia, N.H., one of 13 children to the late George A. and Lela (Brockney) Noyes

Norman was a very nice and kind man who loved life and loved his family and his friends. He was the happiest at any gathering of friends and relations, and always fit right in, especially if there was a project or work to be done. If there was a job to be done, it had better be done, or Norman would remind you until it was complete.

He was a wonderful brother to his many siblings, and he was deeply loved and respected by all who knew him. Norman would never hurt a flea. He was especially loved by his Vershire family and more recently by his caretakers at the nursing hospital.

He leaves behind three siblings, his twin sister, Norma Richardson of W. Stewartstown, and two brothers, Greg Noyes of Canaan and Walter (Suzelle) Noyes of Lemington; as well as numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.

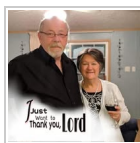
