



Norman O. Thurston

April 7, 1914 - August 4, 2003

Mr. Norman O. Thurston, 89, of Errol, NH, passed away on Monday, August 4, 2003, at the Country Village Center in Lancaster, NH.

Mr. Thurston was born on April 7, 1914, in Errol, NH, the son of the late Dwight and Lena (Olson) Thurston.

He worked on the family farm at an early age and supplemented the family income as a bookkeeper for C.R. West, Inc. and with ice fishing. He was the last official meter reader for the Errol Power Company and after 33 years of employment with the New Hampshire Highway Department, he retired as a road patrolman. He was an active member of Evening Star Loge #37, F.&A.M. and the Bektash Temple. He was a founding member and past president of the Umbagog Fish and Game Club. He was also a lifetime member of the Aziscoos Grange. He held various offices in the Errol Congregational Church and will be remembered for his skills as a hunter and fisherman.

Mr. Thurston is survived by his two sons, Ralph Thurston, and wife Jone, of Wells, Me, and Paul E. Thurston and Dianne Ingalls of Lancaster, NH; his daughter, Frances Sytek, and husband Dick, of Colebrook, NH; eight grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; and several nieces, nephews and cousins.

He is preceded in death by his loving wife, Eunice M. Thurston, on September 27, 2002, a brother, Gerald Thurston, and a sister, Marion Carey.
