ERROL— Patricia Ingrid Dionne, 76, of Errol, NH, passed away quietly at the Venice Regional Hospital in Venice, Fla., on Fri., Jan. 27, 2017.

She was born in Waterbury, Conn., on April 27, 1940, to the late John and Ingrid Cronan. Pat was a loving wife, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother, and 'Nanny' to all who knew her.

Her greatest joy was spending time with her family and friends. Family birthday parties were a very special event. The entire neighborhood could hear the Dionne rendition of the song "Happy Birthday". Playing cards and dominoes with "the girls" was her favorite pastime. She worked at the front desk at the Balsams Grand Resort until early retirement in 1991. Pat loved traveling the country with her husband, sightseeing, going to Las Vegas and especially being a snowbird in Arizona for 20 years, and most recently in Florida. She will be greatly missed by all who had the joy of knowing her.
