WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NH -- Mrs. Patricia M. Lowman, 78, of West Stewartstown, NH, passed away on Thursday afternoon, January 14, 2010, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH, with her loving family by her side.
