WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NH -- Mrs. Pauline A. Cote, 75, of West Stewartstown, NH, passed away on Wednesday morning, January 27, 2010, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, with her loving family at her side.

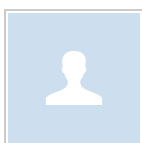

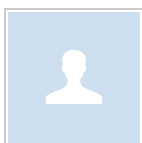
