



Paul P. D'Angelo, Sr.

May 14, 1931 - May 12, 2012

COLUMBIA, NH— Mr. Paul P. D'Angelo, Sr., of Columbia, NH, passed away on Saturday evening, May 12, 2012, two days shy of his 81st birthday, at his residence and with members of his family by his side.

He was born in Boston, Mass., on May 14, 1931, a son to the late Carmello and Concetta (Tutrano) D'Angelo. He was raised in and around the Boston area, and he served with honor in the U.S. Army in the early 1950s. Paul was a first generation American.

After serving in the Army Paul worked for 38 years for the Raytheon Corp. as an electrical technician. He loved to tinker on electronics for his whole life. He moved to the north country with his wife in late 2011 to be closer to family.
