CANAAN, VT -- Mr. Philip Fauteux, of Canaan, Vt., passed away from this earth 14 days shy of his 92nd birthday early Saturday afternoon, May 1, 2010, in hospice care in Middlebury, Vt., after a period of failing health.

He was born on May 16, 1918, in St. Malo, Québec, to the late Alfred and Donat (Menard) Fauteux.

Young at heart and generous of spirit, Philip lived his entire adult life in Canaan, Vt., with his beloved wife of 62 years, Claire (Laperle).
