



Rachel E. Langlais

June 27, 1932 - January 24, 2020

GOFFSTOWN – Rachel E. Langlais, 87, of Goffstown, passed away on Friday evening, Jan. 24, 2020, at the Merrimack Hospice House in Merrimack, NH, with members of her family by her side, and after a short battle with pancreatic cancer.

She was born in West Stewartstown on June 27, 1932, the daughter of the late Edwin and Ida (Libby) Parker. Rachel was a 1950 graduate of Canaan Memorial High School.

For 32 years, Rachel was a well-known waitress at the Colebrook Restaurant. She enjoyed playing cribbage and doing crossword puzzles, and she loved to go out to breakfast with her friends. She was an avid Red Sox fan and always would watch them on TV.
