



## Randall "Jones" R. Rainville

April 14, 1961 - April 21, 2010

COLUMBIA, NH – Mr. Randall R. “Jones” Rainville, 49, of Columbia, NH, passed away early Wednesday morning, April 21, 2010, at his residence, surrounded by his loving family and after a courageous battle with cancer.

He was born in West Stewartstown, NH, on April 14, 1961, a son of Wilbur “Pud” Rainville and Roberta (Spitzner) Rainville.
