CANAAN – Raymond V. Hicks, 83, of Canaan, Vt., passed away on Monday morning, Sept. 15, 2014, at the Morrison Nursing Home in Whitefield, NH.

Ray was born on Sept. 29, 1930, in Colebrook, a son to the late Bernie C. and Agnes (Drummond) Hicks. He attended the local schools and later served in the U.S. Army from 1952-54 during the Korean conflict and afterwards became a member of the 82nd Airborne.

Ray was a mechanic by trade, but also drove a school bus for many years. After his retirement 20 years ago, he relocated back to the north country. He was a member of the American Legion, Post 47 in Canaan, Vt., and also the VFW Post 3291 in Pepperell, Mass.

Mr. Hicks is survived by his wife, Gertrude (Hatch) Hicks of Canaan; four daughters, Cathy Collins of Winchendon, Mass., Charlene Hawkins of Milford, NH, Cindy Losh of Leominster, Mass., and Connie Lashua of Worcester, Mass.; 3 step-children; 6 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren; and a close cousin, Leslie Avery of Stewartstown.

He is preceded in death by two sons, Roderick & Raymond S. Hicks; his sister, Maureen Roy; and two brothers, Bernie & Ronald Hicks.
