



Richard A. Beauregard

March 10, 1937 - January 25, 2008

CANAAN, VERMONT -- Mr. Richard A. Beauregard, 70, of Canaan, Vermont, passed away suddenly Friday evening, January 25, 2008.

Richard was born March 10, 1937, in East Taunton, MA, son of the late Arthur and Anita (Rivard) Beauregard.

Richard moved from Massachusetts to Canaan with his family at the age of 12 and lived on the family farm where he and his wife currently reside. He graduated from Canaan Memorial High School and then attended New England Conservatory of Music in Boston where he studied voice. He returned to Canaan and worked on the family farm until 1972 and then held several jobs including working at Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen, Manchester Manufacturing and Tillotson Rubber Company. In 1984, he and his wife established Squeegee Printers and have successfully operated the business from their shop in Canaan.

Richard had many interests including model trains, reading, fishing in Florida and participating in the performance arts. He had a voracious desire to learn something new and his positive nature inspired those around him. He loved to be involved with community performances, whether it was the Winter Warmer series, the North Country Community Chorus or a musical event sponsored by the Kiwanis Club of Colebrook, for which he was an active member and Past

President.

Richard is survived by his loving wife, Patricia (Bohan) Beauregard of Canaan, VT; three daughters, Michelle Sauve and husband, Michael, of Mansfield, MA, Colette Seehaber and husband, Ricky, of Australia, and Stephanie Beauregard and Joel Drapeau, of Melbourne Beach, FL; two sons, Eric Beauregard of Lexington, KY, and Patrick Beauregard and wife, Christy, of Albany, NY; his step-father, Emile Caisse of Canaan, VT, and six grandchildren, Jonathan Sauve, Nicholas Sauve, Elizabeth Beauregard, Madeleine Seehaber, Abigail Beauregard and Lelaina Beauregard.

Richard is preceded in death by his parents and a son, Adrien Beauregard.

A funeral service will be conducted on Wednesday, January 30th at 11:00 a.m. at St. Albert's Parish with The Reverend Craig Cheney officiating. 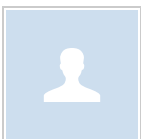
