



Richard A. Lamontagne

May 7, 1961 - February 1, 2012

COLUMBIA, NH — Mr. Richard A. Lamontagne, 50, of Columbia passed away early Wednesday morning, February 1, 2012, with his loving family by his side.

He was born on May 7, 1961, in Rumford, Me., the son of Rose (Rene) and the late Simeon “Sam” Lamontagne. He attended Telstar High School in Bethel, Me., and later moved to the north country in 1979.

He was employed at the Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen for 19 years.

Richard’s greatest pastime was spending time with his wife and two children. He also enjoyed hunting, snowmobiling, and jeeping with friends, in addition to working on vehicles in his garage.

He was an avid race car driver, winning track championships in 1989 and 1991 at the Riverside Speedway.

Richard was a strong-willed man, who fought a courageous battle against cancer for 16 years.

He leaves behind his loving wife, Alicia (Placey) Lamontagne; a daughter, Alexis, and a son, Bryson, both of Columbia; his mother, Rose Lamontagne of

Lac Megantic in Quebec; three sisters, Ginette Gates and husband, Tom, of Pittsfield, Me., Pierrette "Pie" Bernatchez and husband Richard of Auburn, Me., Sylvie Murphy and husband Billy of Bryant Pond, Me.; and a brother, Mark Lamontagne and wife, France Nadeau, of Lac Megantic.
