



## Richard "Dick" A. Moulton

February 25, 1926 - March 25, 2005

Mr. Richard "Dick" A. Moulton, 79, of Brunswick, VT, passed away Friday morning, March 25, 2005, at the Weeks Medical Center in Lancaster, NH, following a courageous battle with cancer. Mr. Moulton was born February 25, 1926, in East Charleston, VT, son of the late William and Cora (Batchelder) Moulton. Mr. Moulton served honorably in the United States Army during the Korean War. He worked for Stratford Plywood Company and then moved to Groveton to work for Campbell Stationary. In 1971 he was transferred by the same company to North Stratford as a press cutter, retiring in 1987. He then worked part-time for Dean Hook on his farm. He loved the outdoors and enjoyed hunting, fishing and snowmobiling. He also enjoyed bowling and playing softball as a member of the men's softball league in Lancaster until the age of 74. He will be remembered as a strong man who loved his family. He enjoyed spending time with his children and grandchildren, particularly going to their different sporting events. Mr. Moulton is survived by his loving wife of 51 years, Nancy (Curtis) Moulton of Brunswick, VT; two daughters, Diana Ramsay and her husband, Tim, of Brunswick, VT, and Darlene Moulton of Dalton, VT; a brother, Earl Moulton of East Charleston, VT; a sister, Alice Davis of West Charleston, VT; three grandchildren, Renee Ramsay, T.J.
