April 9, 1941 - February 1, 2007

Mr. Richard E. Mills, 65, of Colebrook, New Hampshire, passed away peacefully into God's arms in the evening of Thursday, February 1, 2007, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital with his family and friends by his side.
