



## Richard E. Tilton

December 12, 1950 - March 25, 2006

PANAMA CITY, FL – Mr. Richard E. Tilton, 56, of Stewartstown and Panama City, FL, passed away suddenly at Kendall Air Force Base in Panama City, Florida, on Saturday, March 25, 2006. Mr. Tilton was born December 11, 1949, in Stewartstown, the son of the late Edward and Addie (Young) Tilton. After attending school in Pittsburg, NH, Mr. Tilton served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War. He was wounded in combat and received the Purple Heart medal. Richard enjoyed writing country music. The proceeds from one of his compositions helped to build a fire station in Panama City, FL. He also enjoyed riding his motorcycle whenever he could. He will be remembered as a loving brother, uncle, and friend. He is survived by his loving companion of the past twenty years, Sarah Perry; a sister, Katherine Campbell of Colebrook; and a brother, Curtis Tilton and his wife, Shirley, of Stewartstown; as well as numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.
