



Richard J. Scott, Sr.

December 12, 1929 - December 14, 2010

PITTSBURG, NH – Mr. Richard J. Scott, Sr., 81, of Pittsburg, NH, passed away Tuesday afternoon, December 14, 2010, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH.

Richard was born on December 12, 1929, in Pittsburg, a son of Jesse W. Scott and Lena (Merrill) Scott. He enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Corps at the age of 17 and served with honor from 1947-50.

His career spanned many jobs, but all in the transportation industry. He drove for the Tanner Limo Co. in California and returned to NH in 1954. He was an agent for the 55 Taxi company in Nashua, and later owned the Hudson Cab Co. He was also a part-time police officer in Claremont, NH, and in Fort Walton Beach, Florida. For a time, he was an independent long-haul truck driver, leasing his services and equipment to International Transport of Minnesota until his retirement. Richard was also a member of Evening Star Lodge #37, F. & A.M. in Colebrook.

Richard is survived by his companion and caregiver, Gloria Martin, of Pittsburg, NH; two sons, Gilbert Garry Scott of Rumford, Me., and Stephen Scott of Tenn.; four daughters, Vickie Lee Scott of Texas, Sherry Linda Scott of Tenn., Jessica Anne Scott of Calif., and Terry Mae Scott of NH; his 103-year old father, Jesse W. Scott, of Newport, NH; two sisters, Maxine Houle of

Westmoreland, NH, and Molly O'Brien of New London, NH; and several grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

He is preceded in death by a son, Richard "Jesse" Scott, Jr. in 2009; a grandson, Richard J. Scott III in 1990; and his mother, Lena Scott.

At Richard's specific request, there are no public services. Interment will be in the spring at the Pittsburg Hollow Cemetery.
