



## Richard "Rick" N. McMurray

December 22, 1950 - August 29, 2006

COLEBROOK, NH – Mr. Richard “Rick” N. McMurray, 55, of Parsons Street in Colebrook, NH, passed away at his home on Tuesday, August 29, 2006. Mr. McMurray was born December 22, 1950, in Jersey City, New Jersey, son of William G. McMurray and Edith (Pearson) McMurray. Mr. McMurray attended schools in New Jersey. After graduating from high school, he joined the U.S. Marine Corps and served with honor from 1968 until 1972. He was a combat veteran of the Vietnam conflict. After separation from the military, Mr. McMurray moved to northern New Hampshire and made his home in Colebrook, where he fell in love with the area and enjoyed the people. During his time in Colebrook, he worked as a truck driver for Tillotson Corporation, as well as tended bar for a period at The BALSAMS. Mr. McMurray most recently enjoyed driving for his fellow veterans when someone needed a ride. Mr. McMurray leaves behind his mother, Edith Saulnier, of Paso Robles, CA, and his brother, William McMurray and wife, Deborah, of Paso Robles, CA. He is preceded in death by his father and a brother, David McMurray. There are no calling hours. Services will be conducted at the convenience of the family at a later date in California.
