BEECHER FALLS – Rita A. Bergeron, 85, passed away at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown on Friday, Dec. 13, 2019, after a long period of ill health and surrounded by her loving family.

She was born on April 8, 1934, in Beecher Falls, a daughter to the late William and Rose (Paquette) Prehemo. She attended St. Albert School and later the Our Lady of Grace Academy in Colebrook.

Rita was a very dedicated mother and homemaker to her family. She kept a large garden for many years, and loved to can what her family grew and was able to pick from the bounty of the land. 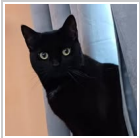
