COLUMBIA – Robert T. Dumont, 85, of Columbia, passed away peacefully at his home on Wednesday, March 30, 2022, after a period of declining health, surrounded by his family.

He was born on Dec. 15, 1936, in Nashua, N.H., the only child to the late Wilfred and Eledine (Tessier) Dumont. He grew up in Nashua and Hudson, and was a graduate of Alvirne High School.

Bob's working career was as a truck driver. He worked for 35 years for Edgcomb Metals, and upon retiring, moved to the north country with his wife. Visits with family at his home would allow for time spent on the front porch enjoying the beautiful sunsets where great memories were made.

He is survived by his three children, Theresa Rollins and husband Warren of Melbourne Beach, Fla., Denise Bourassa and husband Joseph of South

Chatham, Mass., and Rick Dumont and wife Erica of Raymond, NH; six grandchildren, Kaitlin Calo, Kyle (wife Allison) Bourassa, Eric and Rachel Bourassa (fiancé Joseph Kirk), and Megan and Jake Dumont; as well as nieces and nephews; and his feline companions, Honey and Cinnamon.

Robert is predeceased by his wife of 54 years, Lucille (Ledoux) Dumont in 2012.

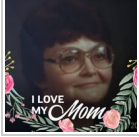
