BLOOMFIELD — Robert S. Marshall ,57, passed away on Sunday, June 17, 2018, at his home in Bloomfield, with his wife and son by his side and after several years of ill health.

When the woods business took a downward turn, Rob then worked for the company installing the gas pipeline and later for Engineers Construction of South Burlington for 15 years before he retired.

He liked to hunt, and always ended up in a swamp, regardless of where he started. He took pride in the lands which he cared for, and his pond was especially dear to him.

Rob married the love of his life, Penny Beauchemin, on August 25, 1990.
