PITTSBURG, NH -- Mr. Robert "R.C." Carlton Mitchell, 72, of Pittsburg, NH, and formerly of Danville, NH, passed away suddenly late Saturday evening, January 2, 2010, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH.

Mr. Mitchell was born in Haverhill, Mass., on August 30, 1937, a son of the late Fred C. Mitchell and Ruth (Collins) Mitchell. He was a life-long resident of Danville.

Known to his friends as "R.C.," Robert spent his working years as a manager at the Louie Wood Heel Corp. in Haverhill. He also served proudly on the Danville, NH, Police Dept.
