January 29, 1938 - July 17, 2007

Mr. Robert E. Biron, 69, of Colebrook, New Hampshire, passed away early Tuesday morning, July 17, 2007, at Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon surrounded by his loving family. Mr. Biron was born January 29, 1938, in Colebrook, the son of Ernest and Charlotte (Baker) Biron. Mr. Biron was a graduate of Littleton High School in Littleton, MA, and also attended the University of New Hampshire. He began working for his father in 1960 and later owned and operated Biron & Sons Construction Company until 1984. During this period of time, he also worked in the family business at the Colebrook Country Club and the Colebrook House. His interest in construction led to his employment with R. S. Audley Construction as a superintendent and with Arthur Whitcomb, Inc. and Pike Industries as an area manager. He was involved as a Director and Past President of the New Hampshire Good Roads Association and Former Director of Farmers & Traders Bank. He was an avid golfer and was proud to hold the title of Colebrook Country Club Golf Champion. He also loved to play cards and also enjoyed hunting and fishing. He will be remembered as a devoted husband, father, grandfather, son, brother and friend and will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him.
