



## Robert E. Kenney, Sr.

July 8, 1935 - June 29, 2012

ERROL, NH— Mr. Robert E. Kenney, Sr., 76, of Errol, NH, passed away on Friday evening, June 29, 2012, at the Country Village Healthcare Center in Lancaster, NH, with his family by his side.

He was born in Columbia, NH, on July 8, 1935, and was a 1953 graduate of Colebrook Academy.

Rob was one of the north country's most well-known truck drivers, and he spent his whole working life behind the wheel of some of the region's best known trucking companies. He worked for many different logging operations over the years, including Currier Trucking, for his best friend, Ralph Sweatt, and most recently for JML Trucking of Errol.

In his spare time, Rob loved to be at camp, spending time with family and friends. He also loved to attend the local fairs and watch the horse-pulling events. He was an avid snowmobiler in his younger days, as well. But Rob's most cherished time was to be with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren, all of whom will miss him dearly.

He is survived by his two sons, Robert E. Kenney, Jr. and wife Tammy of Errol, NH, and Guy O. Kenney and wife Amanda of Bristol, Tenn.; as well as granddaughters Victoria Lawton, Christina Kenney, and Ashlee Goulet and

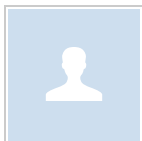

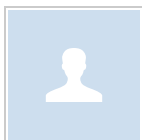
