PITTSBURG, NEW HAMPSHIRE -- Mr. Robert J. Heath, 77, of Pittsburg, and formerly of Hillsborough, New Hampshire, passed away late Sunday, March 30, 2008, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook after a period of failing health.

Mr. Heath was born November 11, 1930, in Surry, NH, a son of the late Rufus and Elizabeth (Davis) Heath.

Mr. Heath served in the U.S. Army during the Korean conflict.
