



Robert L. Cass, Sr.

January 10, 1934 - April 27, 2006

Mr. Robert L. Cass, Sr., 72, of Colebrook, New Hampshire, passed away suddenly Thursday afternoon, April 27, 2006, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH. Mr. Cass was born January 10, 1934, in Columbia, NH, son of the late Jesse and Lillian (Coates) Cass. He attended school locally and married Barbara Phillips on July 4, 1959. He joined the United States Air Force and served honorably in the Korean War. He moved to Connecticut following his discharge and worked for Sperry Rail. In 1979, he moved his family to Colebrook and worked for Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen for 17 years until his retirement at the age of 62. He was a past member of the V.F.W. in Canaan, VT, and he also enjoyed hunting with his good friend, Fred Smith. Mr. Cass is survived by four sons, Robert Cass, Jr. of Gorham, NH, Daniel R. Cass and friend, Kelly Blake, of Colebrook, NH, Stephen R. Cass and wife, Regina, of Columbia, NH, and Corey D. Cass and fiancée, Cinda Wentworth, of North Stratford, NH; a brother, Jesse Cass of Long Island, NY; four sisters, Margaret Kenney of Vancouver, WA, Leis Mullek of Foley, AL, Marilla Dorman of Colebrook, NH, and Geraldine Pettingill of Seattle, WA; eight grandchildren; and numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.
