



Robert "Red" Fissette

December 8, 1939 - June 19, 2013

COLEBROOK, NH—Mr. Robert “Red” A. Fissette, 73, of Colebrook, passed away at his home early on Wednesday morning, June 19, 2013, with his loving wife by his side and after a lengthy illness.

He was born in West Stewartstown, NH, on December 8, 1939, a son to the late Denzil and Junie (Haynes) Fissette. He attended the local schools in Colebrook and was an outstanding athlete.

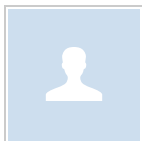
