



## Robert "Tubby" Young Gray

July 5, 1926 - November 9, 2007

PITTSBURG, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Mr. Robert "Tubby" Young Gray, 81, of Pittsburg, New Hampshire, passed away late Friday evening, November 9, 2007, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital.

Mr. Gray was born July 5, 1926, in Pittsburg, son of the late Leroy and Linnie (Young) Gray.

Mr. Gray was a lifelong resident of Pittsburg. He attended school at the Indian Stream School and was graduated from Pittsburg High School. He worked full-time as a farmer, and in 1964 he began working for Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen at the saw mill while still working part-time on the family farm. His many interests included sugaring, working on his wood pile, spending time at his hunting camp, gardening and reading. He loved learning about history and was a member of the Pittsburg Historical Society and considered by many as the unofficial town historian. He was a member of the Aurora Grange and the National Grange, and served as a faithful member of the Farnham Memorial United Methodist Church in Pittsburg. He loved family gatherings and will be remembered as a loving husband, father, grandfather, brother and friend.

Mr. Gray is survived by his loving wife, Donna A. (Bumford) Gray of Pittsburg, NH; eight children, Cheryl Larose and husband, Paul, of Gilford, NH, Laurel

Amey and husband, Roy, of Pittsburg, Lindsey Gray and wife, Ann, of Pittsburg, Holly Gray and Mike of Pittsburg, Karen Placey and husband, David, of Merrimack, NH, Pam Frizzell and husband, Wayne, of Colebrook, Arnold Gray and wife, Lucie, of Pittsburg, and Heather Gray and Chuck of Pittsburg; his brother, Tabor Gray of Pittsburg; eighteen grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.
