



Robert W. Postier

August 16, 1932 - December 29, 2009

BLOOMFIELD, VT -- Mr. Robert "Bob" W. Postier, 77, of Bloomfield, Vt., died suddenly late Tuesday morning, December 29, 2009, in Bloomfield.

Mr. Postier was born in Minneapolis, Minn., on August 16, 1932, to the late Wilbur Postier and Gertrude (Luecken) Postier.

A veteran of the U.S. Navy, Bob was a machinist and served with honor during the Korean conflict.

Bob spent his working years as a safety engineer, first for the State of NY, then for the federal Occupational Safety & Health Administration. He retired as a health & safety engineer from United Technologies Corporation in 1981.

Bob was a sportsman who loved to hunt and fish, and was to be found woodworking and puttering in his shop. He was an avid golfer with a hole-in-one to his credit. He and Sarah also loved to travel the U.S. in their RV, visiting every state except Hawaii in it.

He was a member and former commander of the American Legion, Post 214, in Warwick, NY; a volunteer firefighter for the Raymond Hose Co; a former member of the Jaycees; and he served on the Connecticut River Joint Commission in Vermont.

Mr. Postier is survived by his wife of 48 years, Sarah Postier of Bloomfield, Vt.; a son, William L. Postier of Vermont; a daughter, Catherine A. Postier of New Hampshire; as well as an aunt and cousins in Minnesota, Oregon and Tennessee.

Memorial calling hours will be held on Wednesday, January 6, 2010, from 5:00–7:00 p.m. at the Jenkins & Newman Funeral Home in Colebrook, NH. Interment will occur in the spring at the family plot at the Warwick Cemetery in Warwick, NY.
