January 29, 1964 - December 18, 2003

Mr. Roger "Brooksie" Brooks, 39, of Kingston, NH, passed away Thursday evening, December 18, 2003, at the York Medical Center in York, Maine, following complications from a heart attack on December 7th.

Mr. Brooks was born January 29, 1964, in West Stewartstown, NH, the son of William and the late Doreen M. (Andrews) Brooks.

Mr. Brooks graduated from Colebrook Academy in 1982.
