May 21, 1933 - January 23, 2005

Mr. Roger Goulet, 71, of West Stewartstown, NH, passed away Sunday evening, January 23, 2005, at the Coos County Nursing Hospital. Mr. Goulet was born May 21, 1933, in Lawrence, MA, son of the late Henry Joseph and Clara (Faucher) Goulet. Mr. Goulet served in the United States Air Force during the Korean War and following his honorable discharge in 1955, he married Diane B. (Robichaud) Goulet on October 14, 1956.
