Mr. Roger E. Covill, 83, of Colebrook, New Hampshire, passed away suddenly on Saturday, October 30, 2004, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital.

Mr. Covill was born May 13, 1921, in Pittsburg, NH, son of the late Everett and Birdie Covill.

Mr. Covill grew up on Happy Corner in Pittsburg, NH, and after graduating from Pittsburg High School, he was employed as an apprentice for General Electric in Lynn, MA.
