



Roland P. Burns

February 25, 1932 - August 12, 2012

WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NH-- Mr. Roland P. Burns, 80, of West Stewartstown, NH, died peacefully on Sunday, August 12, 2012, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown.

He was born in West Stewartstown on February 25, 1932, a son to the late Benjamin S. and Lena (Caron) Burns. Roland attended local schools, and later served honorably in the U.S. Marine Corps during the Korean conflict.

For many years, Roland worked construction jobs in Vermont and New York. He later worked as a custodian at the Twin Field School in Plainfield, Vt., prior to his retirement.

Roland loved to be tending his garden, and he truly enjoyed watching the birds. He will be remembered by all of his family as a loving father, grandfather, brother and uncle.

He is survived by his three children, Steven Burns of North Carolina, Paul Burns of Braintree, Vt., and Brenda Fonner of Tempe, Ariz.; two brothers, Robert Burns and wife, Norma, and Hasen Burns and wife, Jeannine, all of West Stewartstown; a sister, Gladys Morrow of Dover, NH; seven grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.

Roland is preceded in death by his father in 1955, his mother in 2007, a sister, Edna Michaud, and a brother, Leroy Burns.

Calling hours will be on Wednesday, August 15, 2012, from 6-8 p.m. at the Jenkins & Newman Funeral Home in Colebrook. A funeral service will be on Thursday, August 16, at 11 a.m. at the Independent Baptist Church in West Stewartstown with Pastor Matthew Coons officiating. Burial with military honors will immediately follow at the Pittsburg Hollow Cemetery.

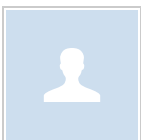
