



## Rosaire Rougeau

July 13, 1928 - December 10, 2011

PITTSBURG, NH—Mr. Rosaire Rougeau, 83, of Pittsburg, NH, passed away suddenly on Saturday morning, December 10, 2011, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH, after being stricken in West Stewartstown.

He was born in St. Malo, Québec, on July 13, 1928, a son to the late Wilfrid and Roseanna (Bolduc) Rougeau. He attended school in Canada and went to work at a young age.

Since the age of 15, Rosaire spent his working life as a truck driver. He loved to drive, and he worked for many different local trucking companies, and was also self-employed. He enjoyed cutting great amounts of wood for his stove, and he enjoyed spending time with his friends, family and grandchildren. Rosaire was known for his joking manner and his wonderful sense of humor.
