



## Rose M. Paquette

December 24, 1911 - July 2, 2010

WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NH -- Mrs. Rose M. Paquette, 98, of West Stewartstown, NH, and formerly of Beecher Falls, Vt., passed away at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown late Friday evening, July 2, 2010, after a long period of declining health and with her family by her side.

Born on Christmas Eve in 1911, in St. Malo, Québec, she was the daughter of the late Gideon and Camille (LeHoux) Drouin.

For many years, Rose was a homemaker who enjoyed raising her family and helping her husband on the family farm. She also cooked for the Duranleau family at the Spa Restaurant, at Jackson's Lodge on Wallace Pond, and at the Northland Restaurant in Canaan. Prior to retiring, she also worked repairing furniture at the Ethan Allen Furniture Factory in Beecher Falls.

She enjoyed knitting, crocheting, quilting, and all other hand-crafts, making clothes, cooking, cleaning her home and tending to her gardens and flowers. She also very much enjoyed having company visit her. Rose was a communicant at St. Albert's Catholic Church in West Stewartstown.

Rose leaves behind her daughter, Suzanne Madore and husband, Eusebe, of Pittsburg, NH; two sons, Real Paquette and fiancée Brenda of Littleton, NH, and Andre Paquette and wife Solange of Goffstown, NH; a sister, Jeanne

Paquette of Coaticook, Quebec; 13 grandchildren; 24 great-grandchildren; one great-great grandchild; and many, many nieces, nephews and cousins.

She is preceded in death by four brothers and three sisters.
