



## Russell D. Greer Sr.

CLARKSVILLE – Russell D. Greer, Sr., 77, died suddenly at his home on Sunday, June 21, 2026, after a period of declining health.

He was born in Lynn, Mass., on Sept. 24, 1948, a son to the late Eugene and Isabelle (Barton) Greer. Russ attended Winnacunnet High School in Hampton, N.H.

From high school, Russ started a career of more than 50 years as truck driver. In the southern part of the state, he worked for Dearborn Motor Express for ten years, and later, after moving to the north country, he drove and hauled logs for Roy Amey, the Rancourts, and Jack Riendeau. He also drove a concrete truck for Persons Concrete for a time. Russ eventually bought his own truck and then hauled large propane trailers all over the eastern seaboard.

He loved to hunt and fish, play golf, and he loved to mow his lawn, the efficiency of which was also questioned by members of his family. That didn't matter, he just loved to be out mowing. Russ was a simple man, who loved to just enjoy time with friends and family. He and his best friend, and son, Josh put on a million miles together with plenty of laughs and good-natured arguments.

Russ leaves behind his son, Josh Greer (Sarah Kirk), of Clarksville; his daughter, Luanne Young (Duane) of Clarksville; his son, Edward Foss (Tracy) of Virginia Beach, Va.; six grandchildren: Allyson and Melinda Young, Hannah and Logan Stokes, and Emily and Ashley Foss; and three great-grandchildren: Penelope, Aaliyah and Isiaiah.

He is predeceased by his wife of 43 years, Janet (Rogers) Greer in 2021; two sons, Russell D. Greer, Jr. and Justin Tyme as a baby; and two brothers, Richard and Robert Greer.

There are no public service scheduled. Russell will be privately interred with his brother in the North Hampton Center Cemetery at the convenience of the family.

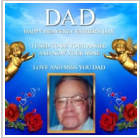
