



Russell E. Rowell

November 13, 1919 - August 19, 2018

CANAAN — Russell E. Rowell, 98, passed away at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook on Sunday, Aug. 19, 2018, with his family by his side.

He was born on Nov. 13, 1919, on Canaan Hill, at the current location of the Chris Masson homestead. He was the son of the late Walter J. Rowell and L. Beryl (Russell) Young. He attended schools in Canaan, and later spent his life as a heavy equipment operator in the construction field. He was a team member during the construction of both Interstates 89 and 91 in Vermont, and he worked for many years for Elmont Jackson. At one time he ran the gas station in Canaan, and he and his wife owned and operated the first soft-serve ice cream place in the area called Frostywhirl.

Russell was a wonderful father to his family, and will be remembered for his hard work ethic, mechanic's ability and always tinkering. He loved old classic country-western music, and he loved to travel with his family to the beach each summer. He was known as a talented yodeler in his younger days.

He leaves behind three children, Eileen Pontbriand (Paul) of Wallingford, Vt., Kevin B. Rowell of Canaan, and Mark Rowell (Brenda) of Stratford, NH; 14 grandchildren, and numerous great-grandchildren and great-great grandchildren.

He is predeceased by his wife, Ruth (Frizzell) Rowell in 2001, a son, Leslie Rowell, and a grandson, Wade Rowell.

There are no public calling hours. A Celebration of the Life for both Ruth and Russell will be held at a later date of which notice will be given.
