CANAAN, VT — Ruth M. Smith, 94 , of Canaan, Vt., died peacefully at home early on Friday, July 4, 2014. She had been a resident of Canaan since Nov. 2009, living with her daughter and son-in-law, Sharon and Rob Baum.

Mrs. Smith was born in Dansville, NY, on June 7, 1920, a daughter to the late Edward and Katherin (Sauerbier) Connor.
