COLEBROOK, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Mrs. Simone J. (Rousseau) Corriveau, 74, of Colebrook, New Hampshire, passed away Wednesday morning, July 15, 2009, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook.
