



Solange R. Hebert

June 25, 1931 - October 3, 2020

COLEBROOK – Solange Renelle Hebert, 89, of Colebrook, died peacefully on Saturday morning, Oct. 3, 2020, at the home of her caretaker and after a long period of failing health.

She was born in St. Malo, Que., on June 25, 1931, a daughter to the late Adalbert and Amanda (Fontaine) Lemieux.

Solange was the town clerk for Colebrook for more than 25 years, and she worked all the elections for the town for 40 years. Along with her sister, she was presented the “Citizen of the Year” award for Colebrook in 2014. She was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary and she volunteered at UCVH for many years after her retirement. Solange was a faithful communicant at St. Brendan’s Church and an active member of the Catholic Women’s Club.

She is survived by her three children, Renelle Hebert of Woburn, Mass.; George (Dee) Hebert of Stewartstown, and Alan (Taunia) Hebert of Bristol, Vt.; her sister, Marie-Claire Gorman of Colebrook; three grandchildren, Travis, Nicholas and Jillian Hebert; as well as nieces, nephews and cousins.

Solange was preceded in death by her husband of 42 years, Peter Hebert, in 1997, and a brother, Hercule Lemieux.

There are no public calling hours. A memorial Mass will be held on Saturday morning, Oct. 10, 2020, at 10 a.m. at St. Brendan's Church with COVID-19 small group and social distancing guidelines being observed. A graveside interment will immediately follow at St. Brendan's Cemetery.
