



Sophia Covey

October 12, 1921 - January 13, 2014

CLARKSVILLE, NH – Sophia Covey, 92, of Clarksville, passed away on Monday afternoon, Jan. 13, 2014, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook after a period of failing health, and with her beloved family by her side.

She was born in Nashua, NH, on Oct. 12, 1921, a daughter to the late Victor and Michalina (Malinkawicz) Makarawicz. Sophia was raised and educated in Nashua, and later married Charles “Jack” Covey, Sr., and they began to raise their family there before purchasing Hilliard’s Cabins and moving to Pittsburg in 1958.

Conn.; 13 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren.

She is preceded in death by her daughter, Carol Mielnicki in 2012; as well as two brothers, William and Victor Makarawicz, and a sister, Josephine Rodonis.
