BALTIMORE – Spencer A. Maurais, 28, of W. Stewartstown, died unexpectedly on Thursday, March 16, 2023, in Myersville, Maryland, as a result of injuries sustained in an automobile accident.

He was born in Berlin on July 12, 1994, a son to Paul R. and Sylvie (Noyes) Maurais. Spencer was raised in the Berlin/Gorham area and was a 2012 graduate of Gorham High School.

His passion in life was drawing, and he had his own beautiful technique as an artist. While developing his portfolio as a tattoo artist, he worked in New York, New Jersey, Ohio, Louisiana, California, and most recently was on to new adventures in Maryland. Spencer enjoyed traveling and made many friends on the way, always keeping in touch with his family and old friends. He enjoyed playing his guitar and tried his hand at writing his own songs. He was deeply loved and will be missed forever by family and friends alike.

Spencer leaves behind his parents, Paul (Laurie) Maurais of Shelburne, N.H., and Sylvie (Keith Dayon) Maurais of W. Stewartstown; his sister, Mianca G. Parker; his grandparents, Lucille Renaud Maurais of Lemington, Vt., and Donald and Ginette Noyes of W. Stewartstown; his aunts and uncles, Richard and Romaine Maurais, Robert and Roland Maurais, Rachel and Stephen Friedman, and Rebecca (Ingram) Morales and John Morales; his cousins,

Andrea, Lydia and Elise Friedman, and Levias Parker; as well as numerous great-uncles, great-aunts and friends.

He is predeceased by a grandfather, Albert Maurais.

There will be no public calling hours. Spencer's family will have a private gathering and celebration of his life at a later date.

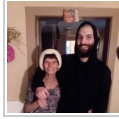
“ There aren't enough words out there to describe Spencer if we're totally honest. His art was intricate, peculiar and unique, a mere glimpse into the depth of his cascading thoughts, constantly exploring the world around him in an utterly Spencer-esque way. He was a walking oxy-moron. Sometimes he came off as brisk, and uncaring, often he was the most feeling, sensitive soul you have ever met. I've never met someone who can listen to what I have to say, and repeat it back in an entirely different, much more beautiful way. New intricate language, metaphors, twisting the words into a much better-sounding monologue I could never have managed myself. He threw his enormous arms around enthusiastically, acting out his words, or performing out another's. One time he did it so enthusiastically so that he ran into a whiteboard with a school-mates glasses on and snapped them clean in half!

Every moment spent with him was an adventure. Something hilarious or ridiculous was bound to happen. Like a madness magnet, it was like he was incapable of mundane. Just the last drive we went on, the madness magnet struck again. We got stuck under a bridge in the biggest thunderstorm i've ever seen, my dog got a fish-hook in his leg (that Spencer removed fearlessly), and after returning back to the house, dry off and falling down some philosophical tangent, poof, he disappears back into the world to continue his Spencer adventure.

Spencer, although your life was cut short - you lived it to the fullest extent. Stuffing every piece of empty space with meaning and experience. Before you got your car, and relocated the adventure on wheels, you told me (loudly, with dramatic arm movements) that if you could watch your life back as a video it would be almost entirely footage of you walking up and down the railroad tracks thinking. You were a lot like a train. We couldn't keep you in one place, you were always on the move, covered in art, who knows what's going on inside of them. I think actually we just couldn't keep you here for too long, because your adventurous soul has got places to visit in other parts of the universe you contemplated so much.

We will bloody miss you Spencer, but we're so thankful that we had you in our lives in the first place.
