COLEBROOK – Steven F. Earley, 56, of Colebrook, passed away peacefully on February 18, 2020, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH.

Born in Portland, Me., on June 19, 1963, he was the son of the late Daniel and Helena (Valley) Earley. He is survived by his fiancée, Crystal Hodge, and a stepson Austen Owen. He is also survived by his three siblings, Karen Ferreira of Providence, R.I., David Earley of New Jersey, and Jeannie Michaud of Providence, as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

Steven was a graduate of Attleboro High School. He lived in Hanover, Mass., serving as the town's dog officer and working in construction. Steven and his then wife Evelyn later settled in Colebrook. He started up a transportation company for disabled students, and he was the owner and operator of Earley Rubbish & Recycling, LLC. Steve organized and supported the PAVE program in 1999, and eventually became its director, a program that helped all children in Colebrook.

Steven will be best remembered as a foster parent to teenage boys, and for his endless hard work helping out the youths of the area. His heart was big and he never hesitated to help anyone in need. He touched a lot of people's hearts.

Steven enjoyed camping, fishing, and spending time in Maine. His favorite thing to do was to spend time with his friends. He will be greatly missed by all his family and friends.
