



## Steven A. Mihalcik

March 19, 1939 - October 8, 2013

PITTSBURG, NH — Mr. Steven A. Mihalcik, 74, of Pittsburg, NH, passed away at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook on Tuesday evening, Oct. 8, 2013, after a long struggle with kidney failure.

He was born in Seymour, Conn., on March 19, 1939, a son to the late Joseph and Helen (Maston) Mihalcik. Steve was raised in Connecticut and spent much of his life there working and raising his own family prior to moving to the north country in 2005 to be close to his only daughter.

He was a roofer by trade, but was forced to retire at the age of 50 due to a work-related injury. Steve enjoyed camping, and he enjoyed snowmobiling in his younger days. He was a member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles in his home state of Connecticut.

Steve leaves behind his wife of 55 years, Kathleen “Fay” Mihalcik of Pittsburg; his daughter, Sherri Smith of Colebrook; a brother, Michael Mihalcik of Beacon Falls, Conn.; four sisters, Martha Padilla of Seymour, Conn., Barbara Blakely of Pensacola, Fla., Julia Cronin of Largo, Fla., and Kathryn Katomski of Oxford, Conn.; six grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.

He is preceded in death by three sons, Steven, Jr., John and Larry Mihalcik; and a brother Joseph Mihalcik, Jr.

There will be no public calling hours. Steve's wish was to be laid to rest with his sons in the family lot at the Pine Bridge Cemetery in Beacon Falls, Conn.
