



## Suellen M. Wallace

November 16, 1963 - December 13, 2011

STEWARTSTOWN, NH -- Mrs. Suellen Morgan Wallace, 48, NH, passed away on Tuesday, December 13, 2011, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH, with her family by her side, and after a long, brave battle with leukemia.

She was born in Pompanusic Springs, NJ, on November 16, 1963, a daughter to the late John Clegg, Sr. and Elizabeth (Portman) Clegg. Suellen attended schools and was raised in New Jersey. Her family moved to western New Hampshire in the 1970s.
