



## Susan L. Lynch

August 26, 1945 - March 16, 2010

PITTSBURG, NH – Susan L. Lynch, 64, of Pittsburg, NH, and formerly of Concord, NH, passed away on Tuesday, March 16, 2010, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH, with her friends and family at her side, after a brief battle with cancer.
