



## Sylvan V. Sweatt Jr.

July 9, 1948 - February 18, 2014

NORTH STRATFORD, NH—Mr. Sylvan V. Sweatt, Jr., 65, of North Stratford, NH, passed away on Tuesday afternoon, Feb. 18, 2014, at Cottage Hospital in Woodsville, NH.
